#### General

The 2016 Olympic Oval Finale/Canada Cup 4 will be held in accordance with the 2014 International Skating Union Regulations and is open to all skaters who belong to an ISU member country. Skaters must meet time standards to compete in this event.

#### The Track

The Olympic Oval is a standard speed skating track of 400 meters to the lap. The refrigerated ice track has a 5 meter wide warmup lane. The radii of the inner and outer competition lanes are 26 and 30 meters respectively. The width of the racing track is 4 meters.

#### Time Standards for all Distances

Ladies must have the time standard from the 1500m or 3000m to be eligible to compete in the 3000m. Ladies with a standard in any distance are eligible to compete in the 500, 1000, and 1500m.









# Men must have the time standard from the 1500m or 5000m to be eligible to compete in the 5000m. Men with a standard in any distance are eligible to compete in the 500, 1000, and 1500m. Junior Men must have standard from 1500m, 3000m or 5000m to compete in 5000m.

#### Drawing, Composition of Pairs and Starting Order of Pairs

The drawings will be carried out in accordance with Rule 244 of the 2014 Regulations of the International Skating Union where applicable. Groupings and pairings may be based on season best times for 2015/16 season submitted for specific distances. For the Mass Start race, skaters will be grouped according to their best 1500m times from the 2015/16 season. ISU Mass Start Rules are in effect.

#### Citizenship/Residence requirements and Clearance Procedure

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU Regulations, all skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

#### **Anti-Doping Conditions**

Anti-Doping tests may be carried out in accordance with the valid ISU Anti-Doping Code and the current SSC regulations. World Records will be tested.

#### Liability

In accordance with ISU Rule 119; the International Skating Union, Speed Skating Canada, the 2016 Olympic Oval Canada Cup Finale Organizing Committee, and the University of Calgary assume no responsibility for, or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or loss of property or damage incurred in connection with the 2016 Olympic Oval Canada Cup Finale.
